Meeting  
November 13<sup>th</sup> 2017**

**Present:** Garry Kurth, Hope Kurth, Jan Barker, Rebekah Williams, Steve Cassan, Rita Cowan, Ron Cowan, Rev. Terry McKee.

President Garry Kurth called the meeting to order and Pastor Terry opened the meeting with prayer.

Correspondence: None.

The minutes from the October 9<sup>th</sup> meeting were accepted.

**Reports:**

Financial Secretary: Becky Williams Fund Summary report was accepted.

Treasurers Report: Rita Cowan`s Reports were accepted.

Trustees: Steve Cassan reported that we would need to get the lawn mower transmission fixed sometime before the rainy season. He will go to Sears and ask for assistance in finding a repair shop.

SCRIP: The SCRIP order for November was \$2,690.00. The profit was \$137.75. The balance in the checking account is \$1,815.91.

Pastor`s Report: Pastor Asked the council if we want to order Gift cards for Holiday Assistance like we did last year.

**Motion:** Hope Kurth made a motion to purchase eighty \$25.00 Walmart Gift Cards, (totaling \$2,000.00) to be given out to the needy during the holidays. The \$2,000.00 will be taken

from the Mission fund. Jan Barker seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Pastor Terry stated that George Daniels family donated a set of Martin Luther collector plates. They will be hung in the Church library. Pastor also reminded us of the Thanksgiving Eve service at 7:00. Lastly, he suggested buying an annual calendar so that all of our events can be written on the calendar. This hopefully will help keep the dates of our events organized.

**Old Business:**

The Church Council approved the Spending Guide for 2018. Becky Williams made the motion to accept the Spending Guide. Hope Kurth seconded the motion.

Nominating Committee: Jerry Robertson will run for Elder. Linda Ryun will run for Council Secretary. Rita Cowan has agreed to continue as Treasurer. These are all two-year terms.

Becky Williams has been in touch with the Dunnellon Chamber regarding the maps. They have been delayed. Once they are completed, the church will receive 25 maps.

**New Business:**

Becky Williams advised she has been shopping for new silverware for the Church. She showed the council a box from Walmart. Each box is \$15.88. Becky suggested buying 50 boxes, which would provide 200 place settings. The total cost would be \$794.

**Motion:** Rita Cowan made a motion to purchase the new silverware. Hope Kurth seconded the motion. The motion passed. Becky Williams suggested having a potluck lunch after service on Sunday, December 31<sup>st</sup>. The Church will provide the ham and the drinks. All council members agreed. Becky Williams will coordinate the dinner. Pastor Terry has been asked by Dunnellon Church to use our facility for a Dave Ramsey Financial class starting January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018. It is a nine-week class. The cost for the class is \$129. Much discussion followed.

**Motion:** Ron Cowan made a motion to offer our Church facility for the Dave Ramsey Financial class. Hope Kurth seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Annual Voters Meeting will be held on November 26<sup>th</sup> following worship service. We will be decorating the Church and putting up the Christmas tree on December 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10:00 AM.

Hope Kurth made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ron Cowan seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned with prayer and the singing of the Doxology.
