President Garry Kurth called the meeting to order and Pastor McKee opened the meeting with prayer.

<u>Correspondence:</u> We received a "Thank You" card from Bill and Judi Brooks for giving them our discarded kitchen cabinets.

Minutes: Pastor Terry noted that we received six new members on January 29th, not four. The minutes were accepted with this correction.

Reports:

- Financial Secretary: Becky Williams report was accepted.
- Treasurers Report: Rita Cowan's report was accepted.
- Trustees: Linda Williams noted that she has received many compliments on the new kitchen. Chet and Dianne Rochette have replaced the kitchen window. A new door is needed for the kitchen. The door will be installed in the near future.

Lastly, the Cleaning list is posted on the bulletin board. Ron Cowan advised that our sound man will be coming in a few days to install a new CD player to replace the computer that plays the music. (The council had already approved the purchase of the CD player.)

- Scrip: February's order was \$815, with a profit of \$20.17. The balance is \$1555.05. It was noted that Barbara Miesen will look into taking SCRIP orders on the first Sunday of every month.
- **Elders:** Nothing to report.
- Pastor`s Report: Pastor Terry stated that the Dunnellon Chamber of Commerce will be merging with the Dunnellon Business Associates. It is not known now if renewing Pastor`s membership with the Chamber of Commerce will produce any benefits for the church. Therefore, we will hold off on renewing the \$60 membership until more is known.

Old Business:

• Shrove Tuesday: Rita Cowan has purchased 114 pounds of ham at .99 a pound. 140 pounds of potatoes and 20 pounds of onions have been purchased from the local produce stand for \$40. Becky Williams has printed 350 tickets. The volunteer list is on the bulletin board and is filling up.

• Church Office Computer:

and Best Buy. Much discussion followed. Hope Kurth
made a motion to purchase
Option 1 from PC-N-PARTS.
Linda Williams seconded the
motion. The motion passed.

New Business:

- The Church's insurance cost has increased to \$852.00 per year.
- The Synodical Convention Information Meeting is scheduled for Sunday Feb19th at 4:00 PM at St. John Lutheran Church in Ocala.

The meeting adjourned with the singing of the Doxology.
